Easy Baby Armwarmers

These simple and stylish armwarmers make a great gift, and are a great project for a beginner knitter. Worked in the round, you'll be delighted by how quickly they knit up!

Sized for 3-6 months

<u>Needles Required:</u> 4.0mm circular or double-pointed needles (or size required to obtain gauge).

Wool Required: Small amount of DK of your choice.

Gauge: 5 stitches per inch (should be 5.75-6 inches for 28 stitches).

Other Tools: One stitch marker, and a wool needle.

Make two.

CAST ON 28 stitches loosely.

Knit 2, purl 2 across row. Place stitch marker at end of row. Repeat **6** times for a total of seven rows.

Continue in garter stitch for **35** rows.

Then, knit 2, purl 2 across row. Repeat **6** times for a total of seven rows.

BIND OFF all stitches in knit. Weave in loose ends with wool needle.
